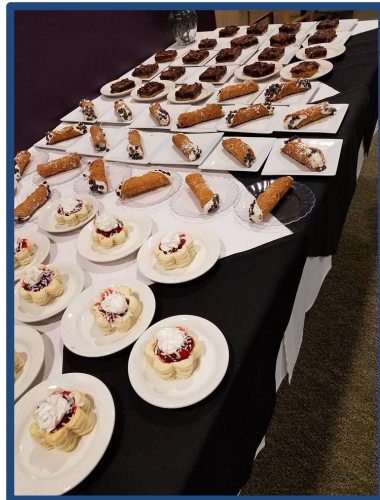


Hospitality Studies (Culinary Arts)

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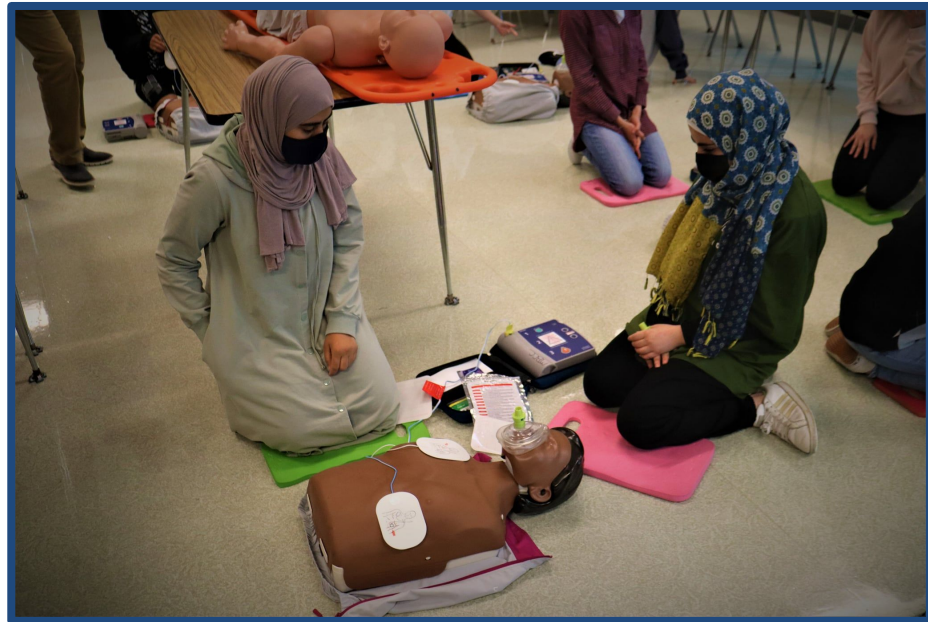
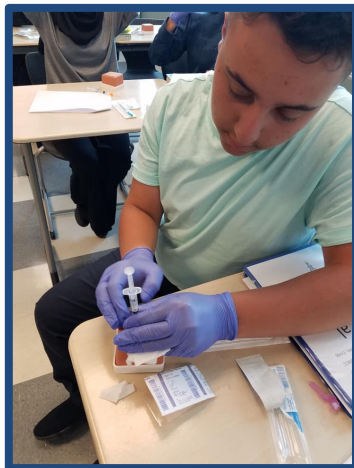


Allied Health Careers

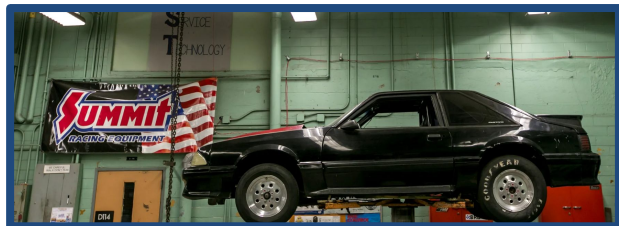


Auto Technician

This instructional program prepares students to engage in the servicing, maintenance, adjustment, and repair of automotive components and systems. It also provides a sequence of learning experiences related to the national Automotive Technicians Education Foundation (NATEF) and repair categories requiring certification. This program may include diesel engine repair. Learning activities in the classroom, laboratory, shop, and actual work setting are combined to provide students the opportunity to become knowledgeable of nomenclature; safety principles and practices; and job entry level skills in disassembling, assembling, inspecting, repairing, and replacing components or systems.

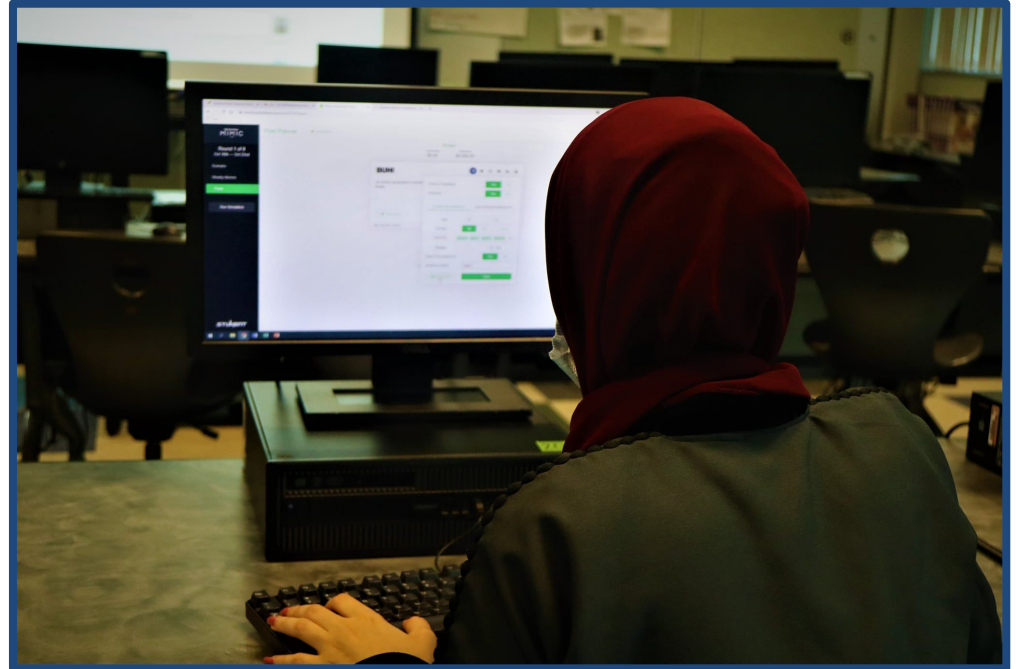
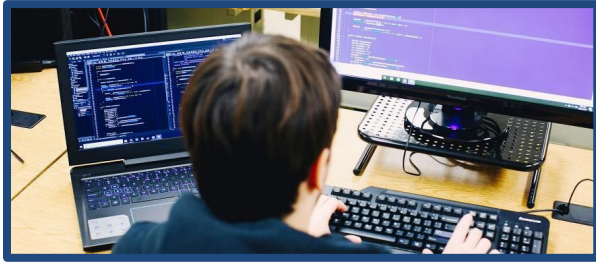


Computer Programming

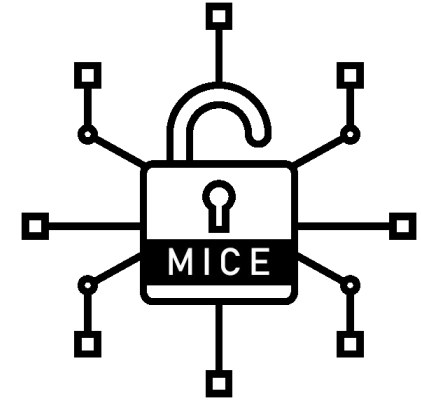

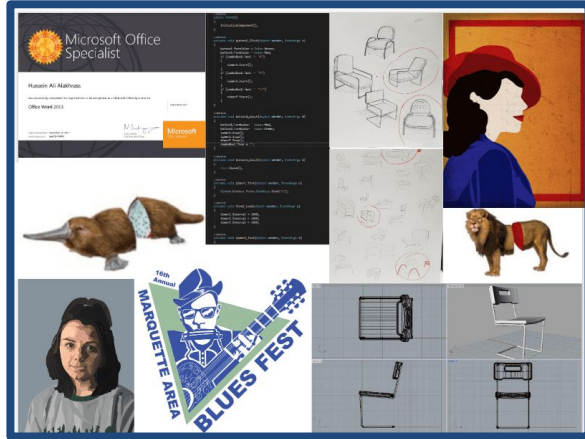
